ARCHITECTURAL ITEMS

1. <u>Sheet A1.1. Floor Plan and Building Elevations:</u> Install window assembly on south building elevation as indicated on floor plan. 2. <u>Sheet A11.1 Floor Plan and Building Elevations:</u>

Provide 8'-0"h. wood framed floor/ceiling assembly consisting of 2x8 solid wood joists @ 16"o.c with 5/8" gypsum board ceiling over Toilet and Mechanical rooms. Provide ³/₄" plywood floor sheathing on top side of ceiling framing. Provide 5/8" gypsum board wall finishes in Toilet and Mechanical rooms in lieu of

Provide 5/8" gypsum board wall finishes in Toilet and Mechanical rooms in lieu of plywood, tape texture and paint.

MECHANICAL ITEMS

1. <u>Sheet MP2 "Clean out" detail:</u> Schedule 40 ABS DWV and PVC DWV are also acceptable for use on this project per Division 22 of the Specifications.

ELECTRICAL ITEMS

- 1. The owner is responsible for the well and associated equipment. The electrical contractor shall provide power to the pump and make final connections as required.
- 2. Power is being arranged for by the Owner outside of the contract. The Owner will work with Rocky Mountain power and the line will be installed underground to the meter base.
- 3. <u>Section 26 0533.2.1.A.</u> At the Contractors option, EMT conduit as specified may be installed for all exposed work and MC cable where concealed should is required.
