GENERAL ITEMS

- 1. Change Bid Opening Date: October 21, 2021, 2:00 PM. Bid opening location has not changed.
- 2. See attached Pre-bid Conference Agenda and Signup Sheet for Record.
- **3.** Alternate #1 Clarification: Work included in Base Bid shall include supporting stud wall construction indicated on Elevations 4, 5A/A1.4 & associated power and data ports as indicated on Electrical Drawings E2.1 & E3.1.
- **4.** Work shall be completed in two phases. Phase I **W**ork on and associated with Floor Level 2. Phase II shall be work on and associated with Floor Level 1.

ARCHITECTURAL ITEMS

- 1. Resilient Wall Base is to be installed around the center supporting wall assembly constructed in the Base Bid.
- 2. Resilient wall base shall be installed at infill areas on both sides of infill areas. Where new carpet is scheduled for installation, the Base shall extent the full plane distance.
- 3. All furniture not anchored to the structure shall be removed by the Owners forces. Items for removal shall include but are not limited to office partitions, desks, bookshelves and miscellaneous chairs and tables.

ELECTRICAL/MECHANICAL ITEMS

 EC to install MC Cable or conduit and conductors in accordance with 2017 NEC. General Contractor will need to plan to cut, patch, and paint wall to repair installation as required by 2017 NEC.



- 2. See notes on Panel Schedule for required breakers. Building is available to inspection if further investigation is required. Contact Ray Hart at ISU for access to building.
- 3. The supporting wall assembly for the Millwork is to be included under the Base Bid. Power and Data devices scheduled for installation in this area will be included in Base Bid scope of work as well.
